



Sentimental Silver's Personalised Pendants are created using an amazing product called Precious Metal Clay (PMC). Precious Metal Clay is a wonderful new material in the jewellery world developed by Mitsubishi Materials Corporation in the early 1990's. The scientists there were looking for new ways to use their mined and recycled precious metals. The outcome was "Precious Metal Clay" also known as "PMC". PMC is composed of micro-particles of pure silver or pure gold suspended in "clay" consisting of water and organic naturally occurring plant-based binder.

After the clay is fired in a kiln, the organic binder burns off, and leaves a pure silver (.999% pure) piece. How is pure silver different from sterling silver? Sterling Silver is composed of 92.5% silver and 7.5% of one or more other metals (copper, titanium, platinum, palladium, and other metals are often used). The addition of another metal to the silver creates an alloy. As an alloy, it tarnishes more quickly than pure silver. Pure silver is composed of 99.9% silver, and nothing else.

Sentimental Silver creates each Personalized Pendant completely by hand. We do not work with premade silver shapes, we create and craft our own. They have a handmade organic look versus a mass produced look. The result is a one of a kind piece that you will wear and cherish for a lifetime.
